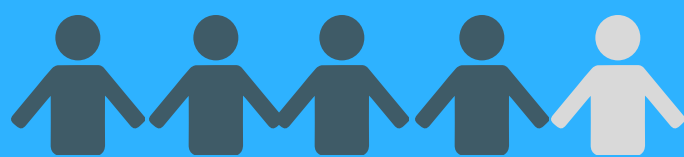


THE IMPORTANCE OF DANCE TEAM



Dance Team Programs have a **direct influence** on the level of school spirit within a school.

4 out of 5 school principals believe that school spirit is a key measure of an effective administration.

A SENSE OF BELONGING

Dance team provides an alternative outlet for young people to learn about **teamwork, responsibility, dedication, camaraderie, and time management.**

PRINCIPAL APPROVED

92% of school principals agree that **higher levels of school spirit is tied to higher levels of student achievement.** Investing in your spirit squads can help to build that spirit!

HELP BRAND YOUR SCHOOL

Dance Teams are ambassadors of school spirit. Administrators can utilize cheer and dance teams to inspire school spirit throughout the school and community through game day traditions, pep rallies, spirit signs, etc.

Parents of children with a lot of school spirit are more likely than those who don't to say their child:



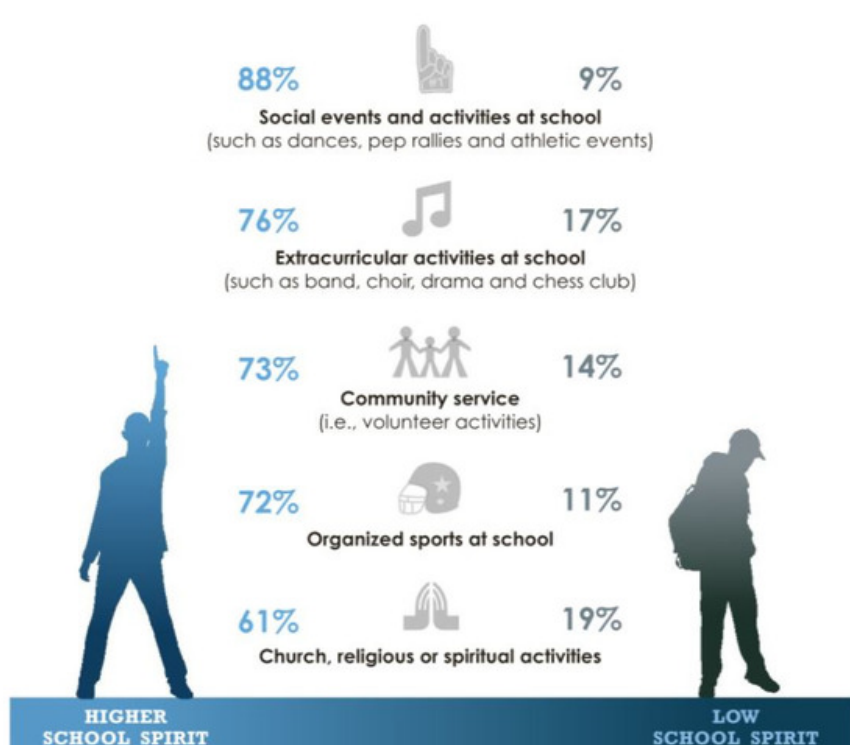
DANCE TEAM IS MORE THAN JUST POM POMS

A successful dance and cheer program can ignite higher levels of school spirit across campus. Tasks a spirit squad can take on include:

- Pep rally planning
- Halftime entertainment
- Game day traditions
- Run through signs
- Chants and cheers
- Themes for game days

Higher School Spirit Equals Higher Involvement

Students with higher levels of school spirit are also more likely to be **involved** in each of the following than students with low school spirit:




BUILD COMMUNITY

A dance team can be vital in building school spirit beyond just the school. Teams are typically actively engaged in the community by attending parades, events, and participating in community service, **spreading spirit beyond the walls of the school!**

GRADUATION IMPACT

Students with higher levels of school spirit are **30%** more likely than students with low school spirit to **get mostly As or As and Bs in school**. High spirited students are **33%** more likely to expect to **receive a four-year degree or more following high school** than students with low school spirit.

Dance team is an activity unique to any other. Practices are less about running plays and more about cleaning routines and creating entertaining performances. As an admin, take the time to attend a practice, become involved in a pep rally activity, or ask team members how a competition went. Spirit programs spend much of their time supporting school sports and activities. Their effort unifies school spirit and your interest in this means so much!
